

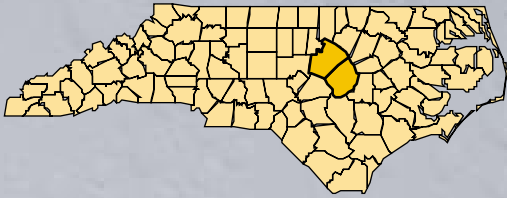

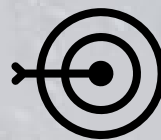
## Project Overview

## Project Description

The project plans to provide participants with supportive services and training, including internships and apprenticeship programs, to move into higher paying career paths; expand virtual technology applications; create and execute outreach campaigns to priority populations including veterans; and organize and maintain strategic partnerships to optimize use of resources and co-enroll participants.



## Project Goals

The design of this project is focused on first understanding who has been dislocated due to the COVID-19 pandemic and then creating a project that meets the needs of that population. The participants are mainly from the retail and hospitality industry.
