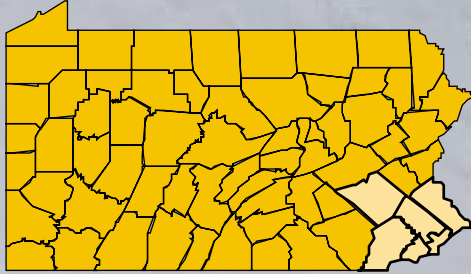

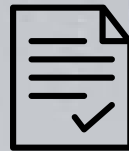

## Project Overview

## Project Description

Funds from the CAREER DW grant would provide additional training and supportive service dollars that would go directly to dislocated workers. These funds would enable the Southeastern Pennsylvania consortium of WDBs to go over their local Individual Training Account (ITA) caps to provide better access to relevant training that directly aligns with job openings in the region.



## Project Goals

The project proposed by the Berks, Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery, and Philadelphia counties workforce development board consortium will move the Greater Philadelphia regional workforce toward high-quality family sustaining-wage employment and address the economic and workforce challenges caused and exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic by increasing 250 dislocated workers' ability to complete training and enter a career pathway with opportunities to grow their career.
