

The project will give priority to individuals from historicallymarginalized communities or groups and individuals who have been unemployed for an extended period of time or who have exhausted UI or other Pandemic Unemployment Insurance Programs. The grantee will prioritize service delivery to individuals with less than a high school education, offenders, and individuals with disabilities.

The project plans to provide participants with comprehensive career and training plans for reemployment and on-the-job training opportunities; expand virtual technology applications to include training videos; and create and execute an outreach campaign to include postcards and social media.
