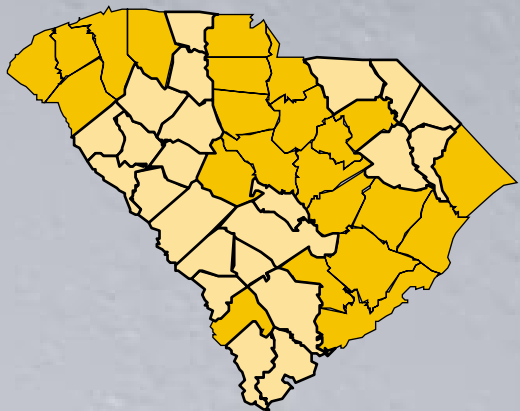

The grantee will prioritize service delivery to individuals with less than a high school education, offenders, and individuals with disabilities.

The project plans to provide participants with comprehensive career and training plans for reemployment and on-the-job training opportunities; expand virtual technology applications to include training videos; and create and execute an outreach campaign to include postcards and social media.
