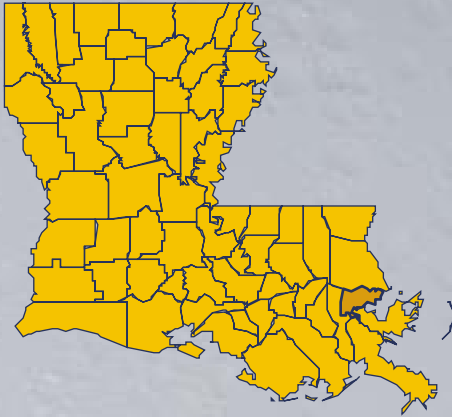

Project Description

Provide career and training assistance to participants and outreach services to employers to determine current gaps, customized training, and innovative technologies; leverage partner network to provide reverse job fairs in which trainees pitch themselves to employers using a conference-like boot camp method; develop a custom, mobile-friendly, online platform with partners focused on human-centered design.



Project Goals

The New Orleans Workforce Development Board is committed to both of the methods outlined by CAREER DWG, offering staff-assisted career services for reemployment as well as implementing innovative technologies. Our design clearly addresses each component of the overarching goal: **Reemploy dislocated workers and serve historically marginalized communities or groups.
