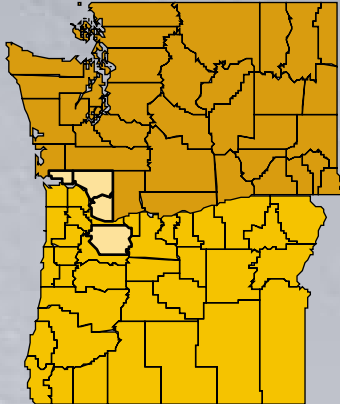

Project Description

The project plans to prioritize service delivery to parents, women, and people of color. The proposed employment and training activities will include the expansion of the region's pool of funding for occupational skills training to support rapid re-careering of dislocated workers parenting young children; support workforce childcare navigators at regional child care resource and referral partners to help grant participants secure child care during enrollment, and cover gaps in child care costs.



Project Goals

Worksystems, Inc. will target individuals looking to skill up and build on transferrable skills, to move into family-sustaining, median-wage careers in the region's target industries: construction and healthcare, IT, advanced manufacturing and transportation/logistics.
