This report to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs of the U.S. Senate and the Committee on Veterans' Affairs of the U.S. House of Representatives has been prepared in accordance with Title 38 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 2021(h)(2). The information required to be reported to the Congress pursuant to section 2021(h)(1) is reported separately, as part of the U.S. Department of Labor's (DOL) Veterans' Employment and Training Service's (VETS) Annual Report to Congress.

This report describes the Homeless Veterans' Reintegration Program (HVRP) administered by VETS and covers awards made in Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 for the Program Year (PY) 2024 period (July 1, 2024, to June 30, 2025). It is intended to inform Congress and the public about HVRP grant recipients' vital work helping veterans experiencing or at risk of homelessness obtain meaningful employment and to stimulate the development of effective service delivery systems to address the complex problems they face. A full list of HVRP grant recipients operating during PY 2024 can be found in Appendix I.

This report was prepared using data reported by grant recipients through the VETS Grantee Reporting System (VGRS) and provided to VETS on a quarterly basis. Additionally, the report utilizes information obtained from DOL's Office of Grants Management (OGM) during the Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) application and award process.



Executive Summary

The U.S. Department of Labor (DOL), Veterans' Employment and Training Service (VETS), Homeless Veterans' Reintegration Program (HVRP) was initially codified in 1987 under Section 738 of the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act and is currently codified at Title 38 U.S.C. sections 2021, 2021A, and 2023. It is the only federal grant program focused exclusively on competitive employment for veterans experiencing or at risk of homelessness. More specifically, HVRP seeks to serve veterans experiencing or at risk of homelessness or participating in a qualifying partner service, homeless women veterans and homeless veterans with children, and veterans transitioning from penal institutions and long-term care mental health facilities.

In Program Year 2024, VETS launched the VETS Grantee Reporting System (VGRS) for all grant recipients. VGRS implementation allowed stakeholders to view enrollment information and performance outcomes, including personnel updates and budget/expenditures data, in real time. It also replaced the email-based quarterly reports submission process with automated workflows and provided enhanced security and improved data validation features.

VETS also issued Veterans' Program Letter (VPL) 06-24, which outlines the HVRP Requirements and Functions. This VPL consolidated guidance that was traditionally provided in VETS' annual Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA). The VPL advised grant recipients on VETS' monitoring and oversight processes, revised the definition of "at risk of homelessness," and clarified the documentation requirements for participant case files.

Introduction

Program Overview

HVRP provides services designed to help veterans who are experiencing or at risk of homelessness reach their full employment potential and obtain high-quality career outcomes. The program provides career exploration, training, placement, and supportive services to veterans experiencing or at risk of homelessness, empowering them to secure employment in stable, high-demand occupations paying wages consistent with the relevant market. Additionally, there is a focus on ensuring that the program establishes strong partnerships between public, private, and nonprofit organizations, especially those that employ and partner with veterans who have experienced homelessness, to deliver case management, employment and job-driven training services, and links to supportive services to veterans experiencing or at risk of homelessness.

HVRP funds are awarded to eligible entities through a competitive grant process outlined in an annual FOA. Eligible entities include state and local Workforce Development Boards, Native American governments (federally recognized), Native American organizations (other than federally recognized tribal governments), state agencies, for-profit entities and nonprofit organizations, including community- and faith-based organizations, and public, state, and private institutions of higher education.

Successful grant applicants must address the complex employment-related needs of veterans experiencing or at risk of homelessness and specifically describe clear strategies to provide career exploration and placement services, career training, and supportive services to eligible veterans so they may secure good jobs in stable, high-demand occupations paying wages consistent with the relevant market. Whether through direct services or a robust referral system, applicants must outline the tools, resources, and partnerships they will utilize to identify, recruit, prepare, and support participants in preparation for employment success. Additionally, applicants must demonstrate effective outreach to veterans experiencing homelessness and build an effective level of collaboration with other programs and entities, such as the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development – Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing (HUD–VASH) program, the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs’ (VA) Grant and Per Diem Program, and VA’s Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) program.

To support HVRP grant recipients, VETS administers the [National Veterans’ Technical Assistance Center \(NVTAC\)](https://nvtac.org/) (<https://nvtac.org/>), which provides no-cost training and technical assistance to HVRP grant recipients and other organizations dedicated to helping veterans experiencing or at risk of homelessness find employment. Authorized under 38 U.S.C. § 4109, VETS also administers the [National Veterans’ Training Institute \(NVTI\)](https://www.nvti.org/) (<https://www.nvti.org/>), which provides a learning ecosystem for veteran service providers and specialized training for grant recipients. NVTI offers no-cost training to HVRP grant recipients on veteran-focused employment programs, HVRP grant management and

oversight, veterans' benefits, case management, and other veteran-centered courses. Additionally, Disabled Veterans' Outreach Program Specialists and Local Veterans' Employment Representatives at American Job Centers (AJCs) support HVRP grant recipients by providing individualized career and training-related services, including direct employer outreach, job development, placement assistance, and follow-up services to help achieve job placement and retention goals. Together, these staff connect HVRP participants to the broader workforce system resources available through AJCs serving as a bridge between veterans, employers, and community services.

HVRP Funding Overview

VETS received an annual appropriation of \$65.5 million in FY 2024. HVRP funds are awarded on a competitive basis to eligible applicants. The HVRP grant has a 36-month period of performance (PoP), which is incrementally funded on an annual basis at the beginning of each PY. VETS provides the first year of funding at the time of award, and funding for years two and three is received through the Incremental Funding amendment application process.

Participant Eligibility

HVRP provides services to veterans experiencing or at risk of homelessness. HVRP participant eligibility criteria include the following categories (as defined in [38 U.S.C. § 2021](#)):

- Homeless veterans, including veterans who were homeless but found housing during the 60-day period preceding the date of HVRP enrollment;
- Veterans who, at the time of enrollment, are at risk of homelessness within the next 60 days;
- Veterans participating in the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)-Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) supported housing program for which rental assistance is provided pursuant to section 8(o)(19) of the United States Housing Act of 1937 ([42 U.S.C. § 1437f\(o\)\(19\)](#)) or the Tribal HUD-VA Supportive Housing (Tribal HUD-VASH) program;
- Veterans who are receiving assistance under the Native American Housing Assistance and Self Determination Act of 1996 ([25 U.S.C. § 4101](#) et seq.);
- Veterans described in [38 U.S.C. § 2023\(d\)](#) or any other veterans who are transitioning from being incarcerated; and
- Veterans participating in the VA rapid rehousing and/or prevention program authorized in [38 U.S.C. § 2044](#).

Annual appropriation acts may authorize HVRP grant recipients to serve other veteran populations at risk of homelessness. Continued service to these individuals is contingent upon future appropriation act authorization. For example, for FY 2024, Congress authorized HVRP grant recipients under [38 U.S.C. § 2023](#) to serve veterans recently released from incarceration who are at risk of homelessness.

Benefits and Services

Each HVRP participant receives customized employment and training services to address their specific barriers to employment. Services may include occupational and classroom services, wage subsidies for on-the-job training, state- or federally-approved registered apprenticeships, job search assistance, placement assistance, and post-placement follow-up services.

PY 2024 Program Performance and Results

In PY 2024, VETS awarded over \$57 million to 157 grant recipients. Specifically, VETS awarded 34 newly competed grants and approved 123 HVRP grants to receive incremental funding for continuing operations during their three-year PoP. In PY 2024, these awarded grant recipients served 15,888 participants. Over 59 percent of those exiting HVRP were placed into employment with an average hourly wage of \$19.49. In the second quarter after exit,¹ the HVRP employment rate was 43 percent, and median quarterly earnings were \$8,710.

HVRP PY 2024 Grant Application Cycle

In response to the PY 2024 HVRP FOA, VETS received 132 applications. Of the applications received, VETS awarded 34 newly competed grants, and 98 applications (74 percent) were not selected to receive an award. In PY 2024, HVRP grant recipients operated in 45 different states, the District of Columbia, and two U.S. territories (Guam and Puerto Rico). States in which no applicant was awarded an HVRP grant were Alaska, Nevada, Utah, Washington, and Wyoming. Of the five states that did not receive an HVRP award, there were two states where entities applied but did not receive funding because they did not meet the selection criteria during the merit review process. VETS enhanced targeted outreach to those states following the PY 2024 award announcement to encourage prospective applicants for the PY 2025 FOA. More information on grant recipients can be found in **Table 1**, and a complete listing of all grant recipients operating during PY 2024 can be found in Appendix I.

² “Returning HVRP recipient” is defined as an organization which was awarded an HVRP grant within the past five program years and was in operation for at least six months prior to any termination action.

³ “Available funds” are the amount of funds available to award new HVRP grants under the FOA merit review process. VETS was appropriated \$65.5 million. The grants awarded provided more than \$15 million for 34 new three-year grants. VETS also funded an additional \$42 million to 123 organizations in their second or third years of the program.

⁴ For the PY 2024 application cycle, VETS had funding to provide an award to 34 applications that received a competitive score in the merit review panel process. Out of the 132 applications received, 51 were non-responsive to pre-screening requirements outlined in the FOA (i.e., missing application components) and were removed from the competition. The remaining 81 applications were scored by merit review panels, of which 34 received an HVRP award based on the review and selection factors outlined in the FOA. The remaining 47 applications did not receive an award.
