Subject: Missile Site Public Contracts Advisory Committee Report

Recently the above Committee, sometimes referred to as the Holland Committee, submitted its report to the Secretary. This report has been published and has otherwise received rather wide distribution, that most contractors engaged in the missile and space program and in furnishing similar services to the Government in connection with other programs have become aware of it. All such parties should be cautioned that although the procedural recommendations of the Committee are being implemented, the substantive recommendations with respect to the establishment of standards for the determination of Davis-Bacon Act coverage are still under study and have been neither approved nor disapproved by the Secretary of Labor. It would not be proper, therefore, for contracting agencies and contractors to rely upon them as a guide at this time.
