Claimant, who is not represented by counsel, has filed a timely motion for reconsideration of the Board’s decision in *G.M. v. P&O Ports of Virginia, Inc.*, BRB No. 09-0282 (Aug. 11, 2009). 33 U.S.C. §921(b)(5); 20 C.F.R. §802.407. In its decision, the Board vacated the administrative law judge’s denial of benefits and remanded the case for further consideration of whether claimant’s work injury caused a loss in wage-earning capacity after June 22, 2003. Thus, claimant’s appeal on this issue was successful to the extent that the administrative law judge will reconsider claimant’s entitlement to additional benefits. Claimant has not identified any errors in the other issues addressed by the Board. Therefore, claimant’s motion for reconsideration is denied. 33 U.S.C. §921(b)(5); 20 C.F.R. §§801.301(b), 802.409.
