Claimant, now appearing without counsel, has filed a timely motion for reconsideration of the Board’s decision in this case, *Perez v. Navy Exch. Serv. Command*, BRB No. 18-0488 (Mar. 13, 2019). 33 U.S.C. §921(b)(5); 20 C.F.R. §802.407. Employer responds that claimant’s motion should be denied. After consideration of claimant’s contentions, no member of the panel has voted to vacate or modify the Board’s decision.¹ Accordingly, claimant’s motion for reconsideration is denied and the Board’s decision is affirmed. 20 C.F.R. §§801.301(c); 802.409.
