Claimant has filed a timely Motion for Reconsideration of the Board’s Decision and Order in this case, *Guidry v. Waveland Services, Inc.*, BRB No. 18-0483 (Dec. 13, 2018). 33 U.S.C. §921(b)(5); 20 C.F.R. §802.407. Employer responds, urging the Board to deny claimant’s motion. Because claimant has not established any error in the Board’s decision, and his arguments have been rejected previously, we deny claimant’s motion for reconsideration.¹

¹ Claimant, on his own behalf, has filed a pleading indicating he has new evidence. In order to have this evidence considered, claimant must file a motion for modification with the district director. 33 U.S.C. §922; 20 C.F.R. §702.373.

Accordingly, claimant's motion for reconsideration is denied. 20 C.F.R. §802.409.
