The Board acknowledges receipt of claimant's Notice of Appeal of the administrative law judge's Decision and Order filed October 6, 2004. This appeal is assigned BRB No. 05-0198. In her Notice of Appeal, claimant states that employer has filed a Motion for Reconsideration with the Office of the Administrative Law Judges.

Pursuant to 20 C.F.R. §802.206(f) of the Board's Rules of Practice and Procedure, if a timely motion for reconsideration of a decision or order of an administrative law judge is filed, any appeal to the Board, whether filed prior to or subsequent to the filing of a timely motion for reconsideration, shall be dismissed as premature. Accordingly, the Board dismisses claimant's appeal BRB No. 05-0198 as premature. 20 C.F.R. §802.206(f).

If any party remains aggrieved after the issuance of the administrative law judge's decision

on reconsideration, a new appeal must be filed with the Board within thirty (30) days of the date the Order on reconsideration is issued by the administrative law judge. 20 C.F.R. §802.205.
