The issue is whether the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs met its burden of proof to terminate appellant's compensation effective March 19, 1997 on the grounds that she had no disability due to her employment injuries after that date.

The Board has given careful consideration to the issue involved, the contentions of appellant on appeal and the entire case record. The Board finds that the decision of the hearing representative of the Office dated and finalized September 25, 1998 is in accordance with the facts and the law in this case and hereby adopts the findings and conclusions of the Office hearing representative.
