DECISION and ORDER

The issue is whether the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs properly terminated appellant's compensation benefits effective May 31, 1996 on the grounds that she no longer had any residuals of her August 24, 1994 employment injury.

The Board has given careful consideration to the issue involved, the contentions of appellant on appeal and the entire case record. The Board finds that the decision of the hearing representative of the Office dated February 13, 1997 is in accordance with the facts and the law in this case and hereby adopts the findings and conclusions of the Office hearing representative.

The decision of the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs' hearing representative dated February 13, 1997 and the Office's May 31, 1996 decision are hereby affirmed.
