The issue is whether the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs properly terminated appellant's entitlement to medical benefits effective September 25, 1995 on the grounds that he had no further residual condition causally related to his May 18, 1989 employment injury.

The Board has given careful consideration to the issue involved, the contentions of appellant on appeal and the entire case record. The Board finds that the decision of the hearing representative of the Office dated August 24, 1998 and finalized August 26, 1998 is in accordance with the facts and the law in this case and hereby adopts the findings and conclusions of the Office hearing representative.
