DECISION and ORDER

The issue is whether appellant is entitled to a schedule award for his tongue or his left upper extremity.

The Board has given careful consideration to the issue involved, the contentions of the parties on appeal and the entire case record. The Board finds that decision of the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs' hearing representative, dated July 30, 2001 and finalized on July 31, 2001, is in accordance with the facts and the law in this case and hereby adopts the findings and conclusions of the hearing representative.¹
