



or that appellant is entitled to a limited period of compensation, then OWCP should issue a decision that articulates this finding and discusses the relevant supporting medical evidence.

The case will be remanded to OWCP for a proper decision on the issues presented. After such further development as is deemed necessary, OWCP should issue an appropriate decision.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT** the decision of the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs dated June 24, 2011 is set aside and the case remanded for further action consistent with this order of the Board.
