

from an internet web site that shows Dr. Zietak's name in a list of pain management specialists in the Seattle area. This evidence is of no probative value on the issue of Board-certification.

The case will be remanded to OWCP. The Board reiterates that a physician should be selected, in accord with the established procedures for selecting a referee physician, who is Board-certified in the subspecialty of pain medicine. After such further development as OWCP deems necessary, it should issue an appropriate decision.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the decision of the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs dated August 30, 2011 is set aside and the case remanded for further action consistent with this order of the Board.
