

any additional evidence.” OWCP did not note receipt or consideration of the additional reports from Dr. Remondino.

The Board finds that OWCP, in its March 2, 2017 decision, did not review the reports from Dr. Remondino dated May 19, July 21, 2016 and February 20, 2017. For this reason, the case will be remanded to OWCP to enable it to properly consider all the evidence submitted at the time of the March 2, 2017 decision. Following such further development as OWCP deems necessary, it shall issue an appropriate merit decision on the claim.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the March 2, 2017 decision of the Office of Workers’ Compensation Programs is set aside. The case recorded is remanded to OWCP for further proceedings consistent with this order of the Board.
