ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

On May 5, 2022 appellant filed a timely appeal from a purported decision of the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs (OWCP).¹ The Clerk of the Appellate Boards assigned Docket No. 22-0834.

The Board, having duly considered the matter, notes that its jurisdiction is limited to the review of final adverse OWCP decisions issued under the Federal Employees' Compensation Act.² The record contains an April 28, 2022 decision by OWCP expanding its acceptance of the claim to include bilateral tarsal tunnel syndrome; however, this is not an adverse decision. The case record as transmitted to the Board does not contain a final adverse decision of OWCP issued within 180 days from the date of docketing of the current appeal.³ As there is no final adverse decision

issued by OWCP over which the Board may properly exercise jurisdiction, the Board concludes that the appeal docketed as No. 22-0834 must be dismissed. Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the appeal docketed as No. 22-0834 is dismissed.
