



The 180<sup>th</sup> day following the April 5, 2021 decision was October 2, 2021. As appellant did not file an appeal with the Board until May 4, 2022, more than 180 days after the April 5, 2021 OWCP decision, the Board finds that the appeal docketed as No. 22-0823 is untimely filed. The Board is without jurisdiction to review the appeal. Appellant has not offered a reason to explain the failure to timely file an appeal with supporting documentation sufficient to establish compelling circumstances. Because there is no final adverse decision issued by OWCP within 180 days of the filing of the instant appeal, the Board concludes that the appeal docketed as No. 22-0823, must be dismissed.<sup>4</sup> Accordingly,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT** the appeal docketed as No. 22-0823 is dismissed.
