ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

On December 7, 2022 appellant filed an appeal from a purported decision of the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs (OWCP). The Clerk of the Appellate Boards assigned Docket No. 23-0305.

The Board, having duly considered the matter, notes that the Board has jurisdiction to review final adverse decisions of OWCP issued under the Federal Employees' Compensation Act (FECA). This jurisdiction encompasses any final adverse decision issued by OWCP within 180 days of the date appellant filed her appeal. The case record as transmitted to the Board does not contain a final adverse decision of OWCP issued within 180 days from the date of docketing of the current appeal. As there is no final adverse decision issued by OWCP over which the
