This office has recently completed an audit of Sheet Metal, Air, Rail and Transportation Workers GCA 169 under the Compliance Audit Program (CAP) to determine your organization's compliance with the provisions of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959 (LMRDA). As discussed during the exit interview with you and Accounting Supervisor Myles O'Reilly on November 30, 2020, no violations of the LMRDA were disclosed in areas of financial activity included in the CAP. This does not exhaust all possible problem areas, however, since the audit conducted was limited in scope and did not include all areas of your union's operation.

I want to extend my personal appreciation to Sheet Metal, Air, Rail and Transportation Workers GCA 169 and International Association of Sheet Metal, Air, Rail and Transportation Workers for the cooperation and courtesy extended during this compliance audit.
