Location Description

NEC is located in Nome, Alaska. The City of Nome is an isolated rural community with a population of 3,598 people (over 54% Alaska Native; Source: 2010 U.S. Census data). Nome encompasses approximately 12.5 square miles and lies 539 air miles northwest of Anchorage and 102 air miles south of the Arctic Circle. The city and is located on the southern Seward Peninsula along the Bering Sea and Norton Sound coastline. Nome is only accessible by airplane, and large freight items and fuel are brought in the ice-free summer months by barge. Produce and groceries are flown in by air freight, and this contributes to the high cost of living for Nome residents. In addition, rising fuel and freight costs have caused the price of goods to increase drastically in recent years. NEC currently has about 2,900 Tribal members who benefit from services. According to the US Census of 2010, there are 1,955 Alaska Natives residing in Nome, and it is estimated that around 1,500 of these are Nome Eskimo Community Tribal members. Based on past enrollment records, it is estimated that enrollment will continue to rise by about 30 enrollees each year.
