Application Executive Summary

This application is for FFY2020 Section 5311 CARES Act funds in the amount of \$12,145,240 that ODOT will award for intercity projects. These projects will support COVID-19 emergency response and recovery and day to day operations of intercity bus systems that provide service to the communities in the state of Ohio.

In this award there is one subrecipient who will be receiving funds for intercity operating service.

The Recipient agrees that if it receives Federal funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) or through a pass-through entity through the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, a different Federal agency, or insurance proceeds for any portion of a project activity approved for FTA funding under this Grant Agreement, it will provide written notification to FTA, and reimburse FTA for any Federal share that duplicates funding provided by FEMA, another Federal agency, or an insurance company.

\$12,145,240 will be obligated through this application for intercity services to meet the 15% intercity bus requirement.

\$60,187,036 has been obligated in grant OH-2020-024. This leaves a remaining balance of \$9,599,991 that ODOT will be awarding for capital projects in a future grant.
