<u>Application Executive Summary:</u> This application includes a total of \$1,418,175 (with \$487,366 Transportation Development Credits) in FY 2019 Section 5311 lapsing funds apportioned to Rural Areas for Capital Project, State Administration (FY 2019) and RTAP (FY 2019).

Each of these projects are operated by a sub grantee and supervised by the Puerto Rico Highway and Transportation Authority distributed as follow:

a) Operating Assistance (Coamo - \$281,550) (Comerío - \$213,696) (Jayuya-\$221,772) (Orocovis - \$99,008) (Vieques- \$76,977)

Operating Assistance will allow the municipality to leverage the cost of operating the new vehicles to cover the route expansion. Given the distressed economic conditions in Puerto Rico, this assistance will also allow for new jobs creation.

- b) Preventive Maintenance (Comerío \$61,887) (Orocovis \$67,936) (Jayuya-\$72,764) For existing and future vehicle fleet, annual element. This financial assistance will improve the fleet's performance, including less interruption in route service due to damaged vehicles. The users will benefit from this performance, especially older citizens and health patients that rely on public transportation services. The better performing route service will allow for more people, including workers and visitors to rely on this service.
