Application Executive Summary

This application to request FY 2020 Section 5311 Tribal Transit Formula appointed to Hualapai Tribal Council, Arizona, in the amount of \$414,079.

Purpose: The purpose of this application is to assist with operational funds for upgrading, reclassifying and retaining transit employees. Operational funds will include expenses needed for fuel costs for the remaining year of FY22 & FY23. Lastly, operational funds will be used for administration supplies/ equipment for the transit facility and assistance with the transit administration's operations. Capital funds will be used to acquire 2 larger capacity vehicles to be used during heavy ridership periods and for routes with larger ridership to insure physical distancing and consolidate equipment and personnel. Physical distancing requires more space for passengers. Covid-19 still continues to affect the community of Peach Springs.

Activities to be performed: The activities that will be performed is to upgrade and reclassify the current transit specialist/dispatcher and transit operator positions within the Tribe The buses will be purchased to provide physical distancing for riders. Buses to be purchased 2021 International Diesel Starcraft Ford E-350 7.3L 138" WB 11,500 GVWR 36+2 ADA with V-8 gas engine, Rear Braun lift and back camera system.

Expected Outcomes: The outcomes of having this grant application approved will be to improve the Tribal Transit program by retaining employees and attracting qualified job applicants for open transit positions. The current wages that are in place are not competitive with jobs in this rural area. The job market with warehouse work, or other rural transit agencies pay higher wages thus making it difficult to recruit qualified drivers and dispatchers. The inflated fuel rates have tremendously affected the Tribe as the monthly fuel bill has doubled in costs from being \$6,921.84 in April 2021 to \$11,434.06 in the month of April, 2022.

Intended Beneficiaries: The benefits of this grant award will improve the tribe Tribal Transit program by retaining employees and attracting qualified job applicants for open transit positions. The current wages that are in place are not competitive with jobs in this rural area. The job market with warehouse work, or other rural transit agencies pay higher wages thus making it difficult to recruit qualified drivers and dispatchers. The salaries for the current transit specialist/dispatcher and transit operators will be pay for a 25% increase upon approval of the job reclassification by the tribe.

The salaries for the current transit specialist/dispatcher and transit operators will be pay for a 25% increase upon approval of the job reclassifications by the tribe.

Maintain safe reliable transportation for the rural communities along Route 66 and the Hualapai reservation. Assist in providing supplies, equipment and hours to ensure a clean, sanitized, and safe physically distanced environment for drivers and passengers.
