#### **Application Executive Summary**

Purpose:

This grant provides \$2,000,000 in FY 22 STP-CRRSAA funding to be transferred from FHWA to FTA, and \$863,000 in local match funds. The TIP ID for this project is ALA210016 approved on July 16, 2021.

The funding for the project is: \$260,000 for engineering and design \$182,000 FTA (70%) \$78,000 Local Match (30%)

\$2,603,000 for construction, including acquisition and installation of passenger facilities and equipment \$1,818,000 FTA (70%) \$785,000 Local Match (30%)

The project is eligible to receive Regional STP funding programmed by the Metropolitan Transportation Commission and allocated by the California Transportation Commission for transit capital projects, including transit passenger facilities.

#### Activities to Be Performed:

LAVTAs Passenger Facilities Enhancements Project will significantly improve passenger amenities at three high-ridership stops in the Rapid network. Improvements will include design and construction of custom Rapid-branded passenger shelters and signage, real-time transit information displays, bike racks, waste receptacles, and placemaking elements.

#### **Expected Outcomes**

The project is intended to bring world-class transit amenities to high-ridership locations in LAVTAs service area not already slated for improvements. Improvements are aimed at creating attractive and seamless (timed) first/last mile connections to local business and shopping activity centers as well as regional transit.

LAVTA will incorporate maintenance of the new facilities into its existing Bus Shelter Maintenance Program.

#### Intended Beneficiaries:

Project will support both choice/commute riders to promote regional sustainability goals as well as

focusing on equity by improving the experience of riders who dont travel by car. Projects will be high-profile, visible, and accessible to all system users.
