This application is to request FFY 2020 Section 5311 TTP funds apportioned to Standing Rock Tribe (North Dakota UZA 380000), in the amount of \$479,789 (full apportionment), representing 100% federal share of the total eligible amount. These are lapsing funds. Pre-Award Authority has been selected.

Purpose:

FFY 2020 5311 TTP formula funds are to operate and maintain public transit services on and near the Standing Rock Indian Reservation during the period of July 1, 2022 to September 30, 2023.

The application scope of work includes the following projects:

- 1) Operating Assistance Additional costs for fuel Pre-Award Authority is being used starting July 1 through the execution of grant of approximately \$3000.
