Application Executive Summary

This is an FFY 2021 Section 5311 ARP funding application Tesuque Pueblo in the amount of \$14,130, representing 100% federal share of the total eligible amount. This application utilizes ARP funding to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus. The application scope of work includes expenses related to operations of public transportation including salaries and wages, preventive maintenance and repairs, fuel etc.

The Recipient agrees that if it receives Federal funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) or through a pass-through entity through the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, a different Federal agency, or insurance proceeds for any portion of a project activity approved for FTA funding under this Grant Agreement, it will provide written notification to FTA, and reimburse FTA for any Federal share that duplicates funding provided by FEMA, another Federal agency, or an insurance company.

Pre-award authority expenses in the approximate amount of \$23,732 were incurred from 1/20/2020 to 06/30/2020. Pre-award authority is being used for operating expenses incurred prior to grant award.

The projects in this application will not lead to a functional, location, or capacity change.

Pueblo of Tesuque contracts with NCRD for continued transit services as depicted in the District's recently adopted service plan. Tesuque is located in North Central New Mexico and borders the City of Santa Fe on the north. The Pueblo of Tesuque is a member of the North Central Regional Transit District. These services will provide greater opportunity for tribal and community members to access employment, medical, educational, and recreational facilities within the service area of the district it costs the NCRD approximately \$50,000 to fund this route.

Tesuque is located in North Central New Mexico and is located about 10 miles (16 km.) north of Santa Fe off U.S. 84-285. Entrances to the pueblo lie near Camel Rock, Tesuque Pueblo is located about 10 miles (16 km.) north of Santa Fe off U.S. 84-285.
