#### **Application Executive Summary**

This is a FY'2021 Section 5311 CRRSSA application in the amount of \$191,316.00 for operating assistance. Per the CRRSAA act, the grant requests 100% federal share. This application utilizes CRRSAA act funding to recover from, prevent, prepare for, and respond to the corona virus and variants. The scope of work includes operating assistance.

The Kiowa Tribe Transit is applying for and requesting the FY'2021 CRRSSA Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Tribal Transit 5311 (c) allocation joint-funding of \$656,088.00 between the Comanche Nation Transit and the Kiowa Tribe Transit. The equitable method split allocated to the Kiowa Tribal Transit is \$191,316.00.
