This is an FY2021 Tribal Formula ARP Act apportioned to Blue Lake Rancheria, CA in the amount of \$27,635. It represents 100% federal share of the total eligible amount. This application utilizes ARP Act funding to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus. This grant applies for \$27,635 in ARP Act funding the Blue Lake Rancheria to support operating costs for the period of June 1, 2023 through May 31, 2025.

The Blue Lake Rancheria agrees that if it receives Federal funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) or through a pass-through entity through the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, a different Federal agency, or insurance proceeds for any portion of a project activity approved for FTA funding under this Grant Agreement, it will provide written notification to FTA, and reimburse FTA for any Federal share that duplicates funding provided by FEMA, another Federal agency, or an insurance company.
