Application Executive Summary

This grant application requests the full apportionment of FFY 2021 CRRSAA Section 5311 Tribal Formula funds in the amount of \$567,566. This application utilizes CRRSAA funding to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus. The application scope of work includes the construction of an administrative and maintenance facility for the Tribes transit program. The facility is being funded from multiple Federal, and State, and Tribal sources. SD-2022-021-00 is an active award currently funding design, environmental, and eventually construction activities. Temporary FAIN 6881-2023-1 contains FY 2021 ARPA Section 5311 Tribal Transit Formula funds to be used for the construction of this facility as well. Additional funding from Federal sources is likely in the future to fully fund this project. The Recipient agrees that if it receives federal funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) or through a pass-through entity through the Robert T. Extended Budget Description

This activity will fund a portion of the cost to build a facility addition to the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Transit administrative and maintenance facility. The expansion includes: - 50' x 64' shop addition - 36'x 52' office addition, and - 15' x 19' mezzanine addition. This grant will fund a portion of the construction of the facility. The total project cost estimate is approximately \$4M. The facility was already put out to bid once before; however, no bids were received. RST will re-evaluate their construction specifications and schedule before going to bid again in summer 2023. Total project cost and schedule are estimated at this time and will be updated when a construction contract is secured. Grant SD-2022-021-00 is also funding final design, environmental clearances, and construction. Final design and NEPA were completed in Spring 2023 Temporary FAIN 6881-2023-1 contains FY 2021 ARPA Section 5311 Tribal Transit Formula funds to be used for the construction of this facility. Other grants may also be necessary to cover the full project cost, and will be reported when known. The useful life of facilities is 40 years. The federal share is 100%.
