This is an FY 2021 Section 5311 Tribal CRRSAA Grant in the amount of \$801,845 (full apportionment), representing 100% federal share of the total eligible amount. This Application utilizes CRRSAA funding to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus.

The application scope of work includes the following projects in support of the Tribal Transit Program: 1) Operating Assistance

2) Rehab/Renovation (Elevator installation)
