This application is to request FY2021 Section 5311 Tribal Transit Formula funds apportioned to the San Carlos Apache Tribe (SCAT), Arizona, in the amount of \$628,657.

San Carlos Apache Tribe is a Direct Recipient. This Application is for 5311 Tribal Transit Formula Program Federal Assistance / Funding and is consistent with the Federal Register/ Vol. 86, No. 138 / Thursday July 22, 2021 / Notice: FTA Fiscal Year 2021 Apportionments, Allocations, and Program Information and Table 10 FY 2021 Full Year Section 5311(c) Public Transportation on Indian Reservations Formula Apportionments, which lists San Carlos Apache Tribe as an Indian Entity Recognized and Eligible To Receive Services From the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs and receives an annual apportionment of TTP funds from FTA.

Funds will be used for service provision in the form of fuel for our service fleet. Funds will also be used to provide for planning activities centered around preparing for a new administrative, operations, maintenance, and vehicle storage facility.

Expected outcomes:

The benefits will continue transit service to our region and eventually construct a new facility for transit use. Currently, staff is housed in two different buildings that are small and antiquated. Many of the vehicles

sit outside in the harsh summer climate and need maintenance more often due to the hard environmental conditions.
