Application Executive Summary

NJ TRANSIT is requesting \$4,578,615 for rural programs which includes \$3,779,490 for FFY2021 Section

5311 Non-urbanized Area Formula Program, \$666,968 for FFY2021 5311(f) Intercity Program and \$132,157 for FFY2021 5311(b)(3) Rural Transit Assistance Program (RTAP). This grant will be matched with \$3,810,676 in local funds which include NJ TRANSIT funds and cash match from the subrecipients, bringing the grant total to \$8,389,291. These funds will be used to support operations for fourteen subrecipients, State administration, RTAP, and project administration. State administration and RTAP will be 100% federal. POP is attached to this application which will identify all subrecipients receiving awards under this program.

Fourteen subrecipients are requesting funding for services that have met all the federal requirements. (Category A). The subrecipients are listed in the pop which is attached.

After FTA approves this grant application, NJ TRANSIT will fund subrecipients services as outlined in this application. However, NJ TRANSIT will only dispense funds for services that meet all the federal requirements (Category A services).

NJ TRANSIT is applying for the required 15% of the 5311 apportionment for intercity funding in the amount of \$666,968. The intercity funds are from 49USC5311(f) allocations. An Intercity Study is currently underway and is expected to be completed by April 30, 2024.

The RTAP will fund the implementation of training and technical assistance projects to meet the specific needs of the subrecipients providing services in the rural areas of New Jersey.

State Administration for NJ TRANSIT staff to oversee day-to-day management of activities including but not limited to federal oversight and compliance, FTA and NTD reporting requirements, grant application and agreement development, finance reimbursements, grant closeouts, on-site reviews and to provide technical assistance to the sub recipients as needed.

COORDINATION

All NJ counties have developed Coordinated Human Services Transportation Coordination Plans and these projects are derived from those locally developed plans. NJ TRANSIT has notified Section 5311 subrecipients that their rural service must be included in the appropriate county Public Transit - Human Services Transportation Coordination Planning process.
