Award Description

Purpose

The purpose of this funding is to provide operating and administrative services for our Tribal Transportation Program in Ohkay Owingeh. We are able to provide transit services to our historically underserved population in our community for most transportation needs including to and from medical appointments, traveling to school and work, for running errands and shopping for groceries and supplies that are necessities. Funding will go towards Operating and Administrative transportation related assistance for FY 2024.

Activities to be performed:

Activities to be performed will ensure that we are able to provide reliable and safe Transportation services for our community members. Preventative maintenance will also be done to ensure that every unit in our fleet are safe for our riders. Periodic community meetings will be held to communicate our transportation policies and procedures and gather information from our riding public. Our goal is to improve our services while addressing the needs or concerns of the demographic we are serving.

Expected outcomes:

We are expecting an increase in ridership. Increased ridership may reduce increased traffic and congestion within our pueblo by serving more passengers. Ultimately, we expect for our roadways to become safer by providing this service.

Intended beneficiaries:

The intended beneficiaries of this funding for transportation services will benefit our historically underserved minority community members. Beneficiaries include elders who are no longer able to drive, community members who do not own vehicles, young people whose transportation needs require services to take them to and from school, work, tutoring and other daily activities that their parents cannot afford or accommodate because they are working or caring for other family members within the home. Additionally, not only will Tribal members benefit from these transportation services but so will the surrounding rural community members who live, work and play adjacent to our Tribal boundaries.
