### **Application Executive Summary**

This application awards the Lac Courte Oreilles Tribe a FY23 5311 Tribal Transit Discretionary award of \$ 150,000.00 for the purchase of a replacement vehicle for Tribal Elder services. There is no local share required for these discretionary funds. Attached to this application is the discretionary selection notice from FTA. The purchase is being split into two projects due to FTA utilizing two separate accounting codes in TrAMS. The total cost is \$150,000 for the vehicle.

In executing this grant, Lac Courte Oreilles Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians agrees to abide by Section 3011 of the FAST Act (49 U.S.C. 5323(j)(2)(C) regarding the phased increase in domestic content under the Buy America statute for rolling stock.

As the Grant Agreement includes an FTA-funded transit vehicle purchase, the Recipient agrees to comply with the related requirements set forth in 49 CFR 26.49(a). Specifically, the recipient must ensure as a condition of being authorized to bid or propose on FTA-assisted transit vehicle procurements, that each transit vehicle manufacturer certified that it complied with DOT requirements for submitting a DBE program and goal to FTA prior to bidding.
