**Operating Expenses**

Operating funds will cover expenses for existing service incurred beginning 07/01/2024 until 06/30/2026, to operate, maintain, oversight/manage a public transportation system, driver salaries, fuel, personal protective equipment, cleaning supplies, additional cleaning activities of rolling stock and facilities, and administrative leave for employees put on leave due to reductions in service or leave required for a quarantined worker.
