Application Executive Summary

This application is to request FY24 Section 5311 Tribal Transit Formula funds apportioned to the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, Nevada, in the amount of \$162,808.

The general purpose for this award is to assist with operations of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Transit with costs related to salary/fringe, overtime, fuel, R&M, administration supplies, buildings and grounds equipment < \$5,000, travel/training related to transit technical assistance, conferences, meetings and safety, update computers/printers, etc.

This grant applies \$162,808 for operating assistance for the time period of July 1, 2025 to December 31, 2027.

The following is the breakdown of costs that will be used with this award:

Salaries/fringe & overtime: \$30,000

Travel/Training: \$25,000

Fuel: \$60,000 R&M: \$19,000

Equipment <\$5,000: \$28,808

Award Description

Purpose

The purpose of this grant award is to provide operational assistance for the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Transit program during the FY25-27 periods in the amount of \$162,808.

Activities to be performed:

The awarded funds will be used to cover all eligible operating expenses that include transit employee salaries & fringe, travel/training, repair, maintenance and fuel for transit vehicles, buildings and grounds equipment (<\$5,000), transit office supplies and equipment < \$5,000.

Expected outcomes:

The funding will allow the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe to sustain the transit program and continue full operation of the transit services for the three tribal communities on the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation; Sutcliffe, Nixon and Wadsworth.

Intended beneficiaries:

Since the development of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Transit (PLPTT) in 2014, the bus system has increase ridership, increased the number of transit buses and personnel. The PLPTT built a new transit facility administration building and is in the process of constructing a bus shed that will house 5 transit buses. The benefits of this grant award will assist with operations with fuel costs and R&M for the existing buses, salaries/fringe that include any overtime expenses for the increased personnel, equipment needed for the buildings and grounds department within the PLPTT, update any computers for the transit administration and assist with travel and training for the transit personnel, specifically related to safety and attending transit/transportation conferences and meetings to enhance knowledge and understanding of new regulations and best practices.

Additional benefits are that the three communities on the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation have an enhanced bus route system with an added route which allows the communities' access to employment, health care, social services, shopping, recreation, education, job training and access to the greater Reno/ Sparks areas public transportation services (RTC). With the added route, two full-time transit operators were hired to drive the new bus route bringing employment to community members.

Project Description

FY2024 Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Transit Formula Grant will fund the transit program with operational assistance such as salaries/fringe/overtime, administrative office supplies and equipment <\$5,000, buildings and grounds supplies and equipment, repair and maintenance including fuel for five (5) existing transit buses, travel and training for transit personnel to attend technical assistance, transit conferences/meetings in and out of the state of Nevada, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe plans to utilize the preawarded formula funds in the amount of \$162,808 during the period of July 1, 2025 through 12/31/2027.

Project Benefits

The benefits of this pre-award will be to continue and sustain the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Transit bus system for the communities of Nixon, Sutcliffe, Wadsworth that are on the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation. Surrounding rural counties of Lyon and Washoe counties also utilize this public transportation service that is affordable. This public transportation service enables passengers to commute to work, attend health care appointments, shop for groceries, attend recreational activities, obtain social service resources and connect to other public transportation services such as RTC in Reno, Nevada. Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Transit is currently working on connecting with other nearby tribal transit agencies so they can further their transports to the Greater Reno/Sparks areas and transit systems. Operational assistance utilizing the pre-awarded formula funds will benefit this tribal transit to continue running efficiently and professionally with qualified transit operators, operations specialist, buildings and groundskeeper and manager. Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Transit is able to compete with local transportation wages and these funds will allow the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Transit to recruit and retain qualified employees.

Additional Information

This tribal transit system continues to increase in ridership each year and remains to be an affordable way for the people on and off of the reservation to use. The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Transit purchased two new transit cutaway buses in 2024 which allows the existing rehabilitated buses to be used for back up buses and rotation purposes. This will allow the new buses to have a longer existing lifespan. A third bus was purchased and delivered in April of 2025 that is used for an additional route that serves the public in the community of Sutcliffe (3rd tribal community on the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation). This added route allows riders a direct bus service from Sutcliffe to Reno/Sparks and Sutcliffe to Nixon (tribal headquarters, tribal health care, tribal schools, tribal day care, tribal court, tribal recreation and tribal transit).
