The Seneca Nation will hire an experienced consulting firm to conduct a feasibility study for the implementation of a circulator transit service on the Cattaraugus Territory. The consultant will analyze the transportation needs of the Cattaraugus Territory and surrounding area to determine if a circulator service is warranted.

A qualified firm will be selected through the Seneca Nation's procurement policy to ensure the required results are sufficiently provided within the funding limits.
