This amendment incorporates additional Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5311 FY25 Tribal Transit formula apportionment funds of \$581,729 is being added to support eligible rural transit activities replacing buses and operational costs. The new total grant total \$891,620.

The recipient will apply \$300,000 FY 25 Section 5311 Tribal Transit program, toward rolling stock, which includes the acquisition or replacement of revenue vehicles necessary to maintain a safe, reliable, and efficient fleet. The remaining \$281,729 will be used for operating assistance to support the continued provision of tribal public transportation services. Eligible operating expenses include driver wages, fuel, maintenance, and administrative support required to sustain service levels.

This amendment does not change the previously approved project purpose or scope. All activities remain consistent with the State Management Plan and FTA Section 5311 program requirements. No new environmental findings or civil rights considerations are triggered by this amendment.

The undertakings are consistent with allowable activities outlined in FTA Circular 9040.1H, Chapter IV (pp. 3-16) and Chapter IV (pp.16-21).

Project Benefits

The additional funds will enhance the agency's ability to maintain a safe, reliable, and efficient fleet through the acquisition and replacement. The project will also strengthen tribal transit service delivery by supporting eligible operating expenses such as driver wages, fuel, vehicle maintenance, and essential administrative functions.
