Dear Mr. McGreal:

This office has recently completed an audit of Communications Workers AFL-CIO LU 6182 under the Compliance Audit Program (CAP) to determine your organization's compliance with the provisions of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959 (LMRDA). As discussed during the exit interview with Rachel Cohen-Miller on February 21, 2019, the following problems were disclosed during the CAP. The matter listed below is not an exhaustive list of all possible problem areas since the audit conducted was limited in scope.

Other Issues

During the compliance audit it was found that officers for Local 6182 voted to institute an officer stipend for the president, vice president, and treasurer. A review of the union's bylaws did not indicate the authority for the stipend to officers66778u. Based on your assurance that Local 6182 is in the process of revising their bylaws to include a designation of authority, OLMS will take no further enforcement action at this time.

I want to extend my personal appreciation to Communications Workers AFL-CIO LU 6182 for the cooperation and courtesy extended during this compliance audit. I strongly recommend that you make sure this letter and the compliance assistance materials provided to you are passed on to future officers.
