Basic hourly rate: \$33.00


Hourly Fringe Benefits: \$25.44

This is to advise you that the following wage distribution was approved by the Bricklayers' Union Local No. 1 of Missouri Executive and Arbitration Committee. The \$1.25 per hour package increase for the period of June 7, 2017 through June 5, 2018 will be distributed as follows:

- \$.50 per hour shall be applied to the Paycheck
- \$.35 per hour shall be applied to the Welfare Fund Bricklayers' Local No. 1 of MO
- \$.10 per hour shall be applied to the Bricklayers' International Union IPF-PPA Fund
- \$.10 per hour shall be applied to the Bricklayers' Local No. 1 of Missouri Supplemental Pension Plan
- \$.20 per hour shall be applied to the Bricklayers' Local No. 1 of Missouri Vacation Fund
