#### **Project Description**

This funding will provide deviated fixed route rural transit system services on the 2.7 million acre Pine Ridge Indian Reservation which has an approximate population of 47,500 residents. Transportation is provided in wheelchair accessible vehicles (buses and vans) along seven routes travel through eighteen of the main villages on the reservation with 115 stops which provides the general public with access to college courses, employment, entertainment, medical, business and shopping services on the reservation.

#### **Project Benefits**

The OST Short Range Transit Plan states that a need for transit services on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation is significant. This need is based on several factors which are prevalent in many rural areas, but is compounded on reservations by the level of poverty, levels that remain among the highest in the United States. Due to the large land base of the Reservation, any type of transportation is a luxury not accessible by the general population due to limitations of income. Access to public transportation is paramount for those looking for employment and transportation to work, shopping, and medical

appointments or just to visit someone. In our eight years of operation we have seen the increase of elderly passengers (60 yo+) from 20% to the current 27% of adult passengers. Clients of such tribal programs as (Access to Recovery, Land Buy Back Program, CHR Program, SD DSS, BabyFace, Victim Services, District Service Centers (9)), Anpetu Luta Otipi, Transitional Living program, nine Oglala Lakota College Centers (9) have benefited from the provision of transit services. The following list shows the communities that are served on a daily basis, Monday-Friday: Villages: Wanblee, Potato Creek, Kyle, Sharp's Corner, Evergreen, Porcupine, Pine Ridge, Slim Buttes, Calico, Oglala, Loneman, Red Shirt Village, Martin, Allen, Batesland, Manderson, Wounded Knee and Rockyford; and Communities: Drywood, Payabaya (No. 4), Red Cloud, Wakpamni/Gordon Jct., Swett, Georgetown, North Route (Kyle), American Horse, Brotherhood (Porcupine), and Mission Flats.

#### **Additional Information**

The Pine Ridge Indian Reservation is comprised of approximately 2.7 million acres of land (4,200 sq. mi.) that encompass three counties of South Dakota: Oglala Lakota, Bennett, and the southern half of Jackson. There are 6.5 (Shannon), 2.9 (Bennett) and 1.6 (Jackson) persons per square mile within the boundaries of the Reservation. Based on Tribal program data the population of the reservation is approximately 47,000, of which there are 38,000 enrolled tribal members. The 2010 US Census shows 20,048 (a massive undercount) and the Department of Housing and Urban Development's NAHASDA population numbers of 43,146. The Pine Ridge Indian Reservation is extremely rural, with an underdeveloped economy and infrastructure. According to the U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs, unemployment on the Reservation is 89 percent. (BIA Labor Force Report, 2005). Persons below poverty levels on the Reservation remain among the highest in the United States with the 2009 Census data indicating 51% for Shannon County, 37.8% for Bennett County and 36.1% for Jackson County.

This project has provided and will continue to provide transit services to one of the most under-served areas of the US. The monthly purpose counts show that employment, education and healthcare are the most prevalent uses of the transit system.

#### **Location Description**

This project's main office is located in Pine Ridge, but services are provided throughout the entire Pine Ridge Indian Reservation.
