The West Virginia Department of Transportation, Division of Public Transit (WVDOT), is applying for FFY2017 Section 5311 Nonurbanized Area Formula Program funds and the Section 5311(b)(3) Rural Transit Assistance Program (RTAP) in the total amount of \$8,073,734 to support the state's Section 5311 Program of Projects (POP).

The projects include operating assistance (\$5,676,034 Federal) for eleven (11) Rural Operators (\$4,490,132 Federal) and two (2) Intercity Bus Operators (\$1,185,902 Federal); capital assistance (\$1,439,379 Federal) for ten (10) Rural Operators; training and technical assistance services (\$167,720 Federal) funded under the Rural Transit Assistance Program (RTAP); and, state administration (\$790,601 Federal). The total number of recipients funded in the POP include: thirteen (13) subrecipients that are eleven (11) rural operators and two (2) intercity bus operators.
