## **Project Description**

This application includes \$54,839 in FY19 Section 5311 TTP Formula funding for operating and administration costs through the use of a Federally approved indirect cost rate for fixed route transit service on the Kenai Peninsula.

#### **Project Benefits**

The purpose of the program is to create an affordable transportation choice that serves the community, economically disadvantaged, non-drivers, senior citizens, and people with special needs. By providing a service, it will connect people to local educational institutions, medical and dental care facilities, employment opportunities, and commerce while hopefully decreasing the overall economic burden of transportation to the rural residents of the Ninilchik Village Tribe. The Ninilchik Village is located centrally on the Kenai Peninsula and is the most economical choice for the development of a transportation hub to serve the greater community

Changes in rural Alaska have always driven the needs of communities. Due to weekly changes in fuel prices; increasing costs of living, and commuting long distances for work has increased the need for the longer commutes between communities. Having access to economic centers provide unique challenges for non-drivers and the elderly and also affects commuters who need access to schools, medical care, and commerce. Starting in 2005 the Ninilchik Village Tribe has engaged in efforts to address the transportation needs of the community. Rural communities in Alaska have few places for commuters to meet and develop basic transportation activities such as carpooling. The tribe constructed a building and provided a place for commuter's to engage in transportation activities. Now, instead of parking cars in a variety of places, there is a dedicated place to do this. This has provided for carpooling, ride sharing and a meeting place for commuters. The tribe realizes that they are not meeting the larger needs of the community any longer and has proposed to provide a bus service to meet these needs.

The tribe intends to meet these transportation needs through the transit program, which would include service to the neighboring communities of Clam Gulch, Kasilof, Kenai, Soldotna, Happy Valley, and Anchor Point. Ninilchik is centrally located on the Kenai Peninsula and is an ideal location for a transportation hub. Connecting routes, through these communities, will provide access to smaller communities along the way and provide for the fundamental need of the Alaska Native community to interact with a modern world using a sustainable transportation system. The transit system will include three basic routes consisting of local area, Redline North and Blueline South. Each route will operate independently and be scheduled for concurrent connections at the Ninilchik transit hub. Creating agreements with local land owners has also provided an opportunity to develop bus stops and pick up points along the identified routes. The service will provide transportation choices to a combined population of approximately 26,000 people of which 14% are elderly (2010 Census). The expansion of the program includes obtaining a small bus that will provide transportation to the

north and south locality of Ninilchik. The Ninilchik program will provide a service area to include travel 45 miles to the north (Kenai) and 35 miles south (Homer) of Ninilchik to northern and southern destinations. Scheduling will allow for a commuter to travel from the northern Kenai Peninsula to the southern Kenai Peninsula twice a day. The projected outcomes of this proposal will provide for a regularly scheduled service for commuters, reduce local emissions, promote efficient travel, and reduce accidents on the Kenai Peninsula.
