DETERMINATION

Determination of a Complaint Filed under Title IV
of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959

On February 6, 2018, the Secretary of Labor received a complaint alleging violations of Section 401 of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act of 1959 (LMRDA), in the regularly scheduled election of officers conducted on November 27, 2017, by American Postal Workers Union (APWU) Local 2247 in Green Bay, Wisconsin.

Pursuant to Sections 402 and 601 of the LMRDA, the Department of Labor conducted an investigation. The investigation disclosed that the Local failed to provide a proper notice of nominations and failed to treat candidates equally with respect to distributing campaign literature when the literature was edited prior to publishing.

Apprised of these findings, APWU, Local 2247 agreed to conduct new nominations and a new election of officers under the supervision of the Secretary of Labor, in accordance with Title IV of the LMRDA. The agreed upon remedial election was concluded on June 26, 2018. It is, therefore,

DETERMINED, that there is probable cause to believe that violations of Title IV of the LMRDA occurred which may have affected the outcome of the election conducted by American Postal Workers Union (APWU) Local 2247 on November 27, 2017, but that these violations have been remedied by the new election, conducted in accordance with Title IV of the LMRDA, under the supervision of the Secretary of Labor, on June 26, 2018.

Therefore, civil action under Section 402(b) of the LMRDA to set aside the election conducted on November 27, 2017 is not warranted.
