Dear Mr. Hill:

This is in response to your continuing hardship exemption request for International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, Local Lodge 2061, LM File No. [REDACTED] 140, for the fiscal years ending December 31, 2007. Your request dated March 14, 2008 was received by the Office of Labor-Management Standards (OLMS) on March 14, 2008. A continuing hardship exemption request requires the requesting union to demonstrate that it cannot file Form LM-2 electronically without undue burden or expense.

Your request for a continuing hardship exemption was based upon the following information stated in your letter:

You filed an LM-3 for your 2006 fiscal year, but must file an LM-2 for your 2007 fiscal year because strike contributions took you well over the filing limit for the LM-3. You must renew your electronic signature and anticipate being able to electronically file your union's Form LM-2 by April 30.

OLMS grants your continuing hardship exemption request for filing Form LM-2 for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2007, based on the information that you have provided until April 30. Failure to electronically file by this date will result in your union being considered delinquent in its filing for the 2007 fiscal year.
