This is in response to your continuing hardship exemption request for International Alliance of Theatrical Stage Employees, Local B-751, LM File Number [REDACTED] for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2007. Your request dated June 20, 2008 was received by the Office of Labor-Management Standards (OLMS) on June 20, 2008. A continuing hardship exemption request requires the requesting union to demonstrate that it cannot file Form LM-2 electronically without undue burden or expense.
